### *Greetings to you!*

Since the last newsletter, Progress Energy has assured the City again that Ridgewood is still on their schedule of priorities for the undergrounding of utilities.

The City met with Progress Energy on May 5, 2005 to review the projects progress. In the meeting we were informed that all of the easements for the project have been completed and Progress Energy has scheduled the undergrounding for this Summer (2005). You may have already noticed that Progress Energy has been out in the neighborhood staking areas in preparation for the undergrounding.

In addition to the undergrounding, there have been some other changes due to Winter Park no longer having their power service provided by Progress Energy. Progress Energy has been busy removing their power lines from the poles that are now the

property of the City of Winter Park which has resulted in new temporary utility poles being installed in the Sunnyside Drive area. New temporary poles have been installed to allow service to the Maitland properties until the undergrounding of the utilities of the QNP are completed. Progress Energy is now in the process of finalizing the plans for the undergrounding in the areas that were affected by Winter Park power conversion. They will be meeting with Maitland staff to review their proposed design as soon as it is completed.

Once the undergrounding has begun, the City will schedule the design phase. During this phase, the City will meet with the Ridgewood Block Captains to review the design plans.
